Note to Students:

- Check your timetable carefully so you know what exam you have in each session, it is a good idea to highlight or underline the examination you are taking in each session.
- Yr12 Btec Students please see those exams highlighted that you are scheduled for (along with any yr 13 students taking these subjects) please speak to your subject teacher if you are unsure.

Daily Arrangements:

All students must meet in the sixth form study area by 8.45 for 9.00am and 12.45 for 1.00pm start. You will be called into the Sports Hall, leaving your bags and phones in the sixth form. Sit at the desk with your named label on it. Any students who have been advised they will be sitting their examinations in an alternative venue should follow the directions given to them by the progress centre.

Points to remember:

- You are advised not to bring a mobile phone, I-pod or any other electronic equipment (except your calculator) into school during the examination period as they are not allowed in to the exam room. If you do bring any such items into school please ensure you hand them in when asked to do so before the exam starts. They will be confiscated if you are caught with them in the exam room once the exam has started.
- Please make sure you have all the equipment you will need for your exam in a see-through container or plastic bag, you will not be able to borrow from other students during the exam. This should include black pallpoint pens, pencils as well as your calculator and mathematical equipment, ruler and eraser. Small water bottle/a are allowed, labels MUST be removed.
- Once the exam has started you will not be permitted to leave the room so please ensure you have made yourself comfortable before entry.
- If you are late go to sixth form reception, they will inform me you have arrived. Under no circumstances must you enter the exam room unaccompanied.
